### JAPAN

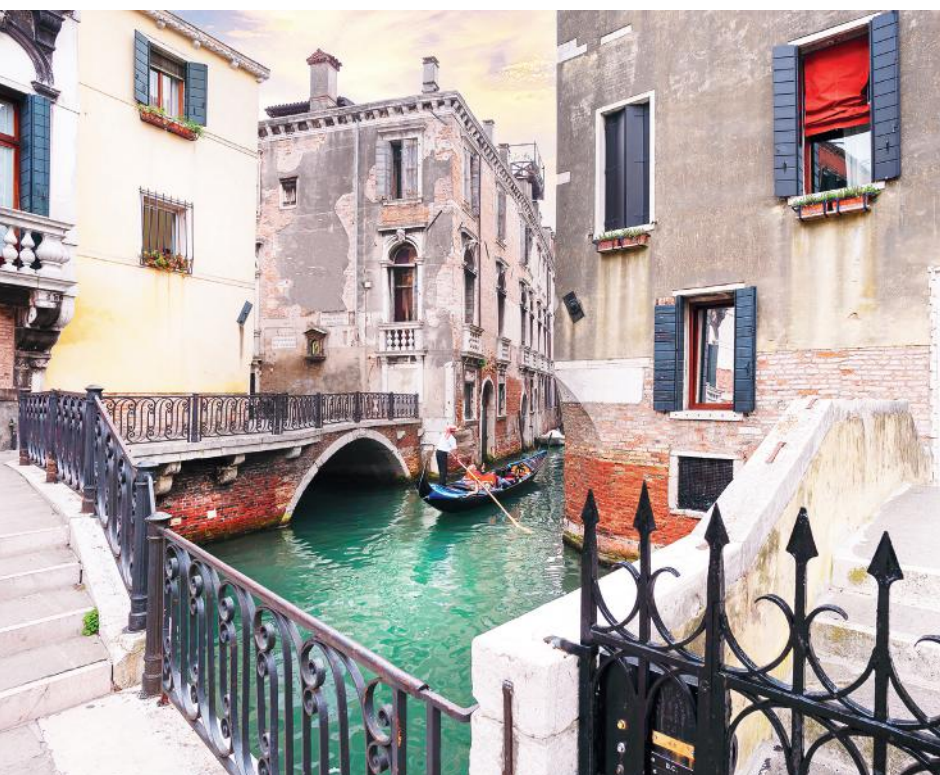

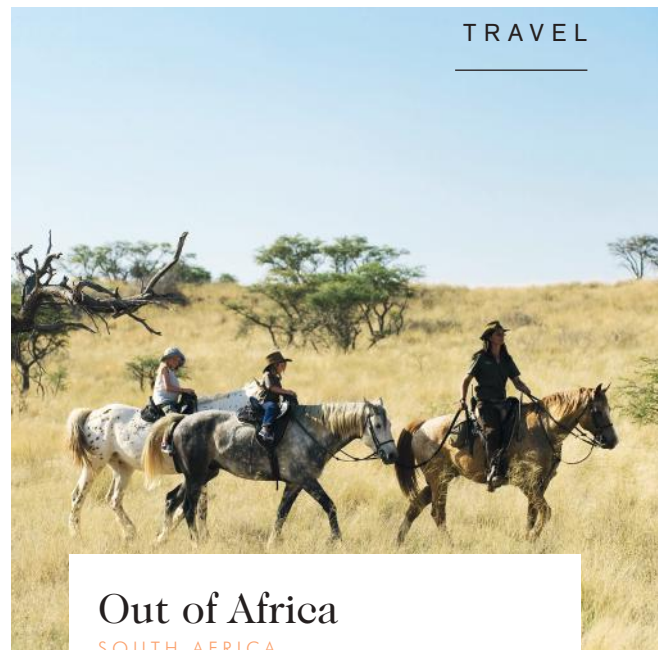




## Andalusian Adventure
